Fixing of polystomatid parasites

Examine urinary bladder of frogs and bladder, FOR FLAT FIXING IN 10% FORMALIN mouth and eyes of freshwater turtles. If possible use 10% neutral buffered formalin. Fix first parasite in good quality 70% ethanol. Fix the A1 Transfer in a drop of water on a microscope slide. remainder flat in 10% formalin (A). If more than 10 A2 Heat with lighter from below for about 5 sec. Until parasites fix some in 70% ethanol (B) and some directly parasite stop moving and stretch out. in formalin. Thus from step A2 directly to step A8. A3 Put drop of formalin on coverslip and place on parasite. For any questions and further information, contact: A4 Place in Petri dish and leave for 1 hour.
